Dear Supporters of US-France Relations,

The Paris Committee of Chicago Sister Cities International (CSCI) is delighted to announce that we are celebrating the **20th Anniversary** of the sister city relationship between Chicago and Paris.

Our Committee's 10-day anniversary celebration will begin **Friday, October 7, 2016**, with a reception for 300 French runners participating in the Bank of America Chicago Marathon (the 20th year in a row that we host this reception). During the following week and a half, various arts, educational and cultural events are planned, with a fundraising gala dinner at the Chicago Yacht Club on **Friday, October 14th**, to which the mayors of both Chicago and Paris are invited and for which Mayor Rahm Emanuel is serving as Honorary Chair. Finally, on **Sunday, October 16th**, rowers from Chicago and Paris will compete in a rowing marathon – a full 26.2 miles – on the Chicago River.

Entirely self-funded and run by volunteers, the Paris Committee of CSCI engages in programming focused on business, arts and culture, education and sports that strengthen the ties between Chicago and Paris. Our last major fundraising effort was for the 10th Anniversary of the Chicago-Paris sister city relationship, and those funds have enabled us to continue our programming for the past decade. As Co-Chairs of the Paris Committee, we are writing to seek your generous support of this year's fundraising efforts, so we may continue our programming for another decade.

Of all the programming the committee has undertaken, our proudest accomplishment is the establishment of over a dozen ongoing sister school relationships between Chicago and Paris. These sister school relationships have been formally recognized (via an MOU) and applauded by Chicago Public Schools and l'Académie de Paris. Consisting of everything from pen pals to teachers taking turns teaching each other's classes via Skype to actual student trips to their sister schools, for most of these high school students, these exchanges are their first opportunity to get to know the world. Once they learn through first-hand experience how much they share with their foreign counterparts, they are forever changed. This is grass-roots diplomacy at its finest.

While we have been able to give stipends to schools to help support their exchanges, the list of schools that would like to be matched with a sister school continues to grow. In order for us to be able to continue this wonderful program, as well as our other activities that befit a great city on the world stage, we need your your tax-deductible support.
